<u>A PREPOSITIONAL PHRASE BEGINS WITH A PREPOSITION AND ENDS WITH A NOUN OR PRONOUN</u>. That noun or pronoun is called the object of the preposition.

after dinner (<u>after</u> is the preposition)

(dinner is the object of the preposition)

(after dinner is the prepositional phrase)

without you (without is the preposition)

(you is the object of the preposition)

(without you is the prepositional phrase)
