

A PREPOSITIONAL PHRASE BEGINS WITH A PREPOSITION AND ENDS WITH A NOUN OR PRONOUN. That noun or pronoun is called the object of the preposition.

after dinner	( <u>after</u> is the preposition)
	( <u>dinner</u> is the object of the preposition)
	( <u>after dinner</u> is the prepositional phrase)
without you	( <u>without</u> is the preposition)
	( <u>you</u> is the object of the preposition)
	( <u>without you</u> is the prepositional phrase)
